Named after the Greek goddess of wise counsel, the website is regularly updated with news about upcoming equal opportunities events and showcases the work participating partners are doing towards gender equality and family friendliness. It also contains numerous suggestions for how researchers can make use of their research alliance's DFG gender equality funds.

The website is published in English and is aimed first and foremost at the members of the participating research alliances. However, it is also freely accessible to the rest of the academic community and the public — to female\* researchers and researchers of other underrepresented genders who are pursuing an academic career, to parents who seek more balance between academia and their family life, to supervisors who are looking for inspiration for equal opportunities measures, and to everyone who is interested in gender, diversity, and anti-discrimination.


